



# HOW TO NAIL YOUR INTERVIEW

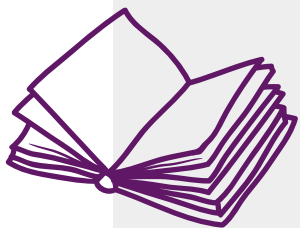
Your success is our number one priority and we want to make sure you're fully armed and prepped for your interview.

## HERE ARE SOME TIPS TO HELP YOU ALONG THE WAY



### **Research the company**

Take a good look at their website, social media and news to get a good understanding of them.



### **Read the entire job description**

It is essential you are able to clearly explain why you're applying and why it's of interest.



### **Ask lots of questions**

Make them relevant to the role, the company and the environment. It will impress them.



### **Know your strengths**

Think about how they apply to the role & give examples of how you've demonstrated them.



### **Think about a weakness**

Explain how you can overcome this and flip it in to a positive thing.

# EXTRA TIPS FOR SUCCESS

**1**

## CHECK THE LOCATION

Is your interview online or in person? If it's in person, make sure you do a trial run if you're unsure how to get there. If it's online, make sure you have the right software/programme installed.

**2**

## GET THERE EARLY

Always be early, we recommend 15 minutes, which gives you plenty of time to relax and calm your nerves before the interview.

**3**

## THINK OF IT AS A MEETING

This is your opportunity to learn more about the role, the company and how well it suits you too; an interview is a two way street, not an interrogation.

**4**

## LOOK THE PART

Dress in appropriate attire for the role (i.e. suit or a smart outfit), keep jewellery to a minimum, and be well groomed.

**5**

## STAY POSITIVE

Start all your conversations and answers positively, never bring negativity to the room - especially about previous employers!

**6**

## BE YOURSELF

Always be yourself. You have been selected for an interview and they already like what they have seen.
